**RELEASE FORM FOR USING  
PATIENT'S OWN EYEGLOSS FRAMES**

1. We use the utmost care when manufacturing and inserting lenses into our patients' own frames. However, a previously worn frame will occasionally break in the process. **Plastic materials become brittle and solder points on metal frames can weaken over time.**
2. We and our optical laboratories cannot be held responsible if breakage occurs during the process of putting NEW lenses in your OWN eyeglass frames.
3. Your prescription lenses are an investment in your vision. Because of this, we highly recommend that you order them to be placed in a new, warranted frame.
4. If you choose to order NEW lenses to be put in your OWN frame and it breaks during the process, **you will be responsible for the purchase price of (A) a new eyeglass frame and (B) another set of ophthalmic lenses to be cut and fit into that new frame.**
